USDA Announces \$450 Million in New Funding for Higher Biofuel Blending Infrastructure Grants

Last month, USDA announced that it will begin accepting new applications for \$450 million in grants through Higher Blends Infrastructure Incentive Program (HBIIP). These grants support the infrastructure needed to lower out-of-pocket costs for energy marketers to install and upgrade biofuel-related infrastructure such as pumps, dispensers and storage tanks. The HBIIP funds are available for both retail and wholesale fueling/storage facilities. There will be five application windows to distribute the \$450 million in HBIIP grants between July 1, 2023, and September 30, 2024. A sixth application window will be opened if funding has not been exhausted.
