Waiver Extension Sought- State Requests Additional Information

As we have reported, the state has approved a waiver for truck weight and hours of service, but it expires this Thursday, February 5th. On Friday we, along with the Propane Gas Association, asked for an extension, but the response to date from the state has not been encouraging.

Consequently, we need concrete data to support the waiver extension such as specific terminal delays (estimated time waits, wait volumes, etc.) specific details on continued treacherous road conditions to/from pick up/delivery locations as well as information on backlogs of customer heating deliveries. The sooner we can have this information, the better. As I will be at the Capitol all day, please email this information to elizabeth@vpcma.com or zach@eisenmanassociates.com today. It will be shared with state decision makers immediately.

If you can provide this information today, we have a reasonable chance for an extension. If not, it's unlikely.
