Unified Carrier Registration (UCR) Deadline is April 5

The UCR (Unified Carrier Registration) is a program that replaced the (SSRS) Single State Registration System in 2007. The UCR Program requires individuals and companies that operate commercial motor vehicles in interstate or international commerce to register their business with a participating state and pay an annual fee based on the size of their fleet.

Like SSRS, fees collected from the UCR system will be used by the states to support its safety programs and USDOT officer training. Unlike SSRS, the UCR system increases the number of fee-eligible transportation companies and its owned equipment, but lowers the fee per company. This year the UCR January 5 annual registration date was delayed to April 5 to give the UCR Board time to set lower registration fees because the amount of fees collected last year in the 41 participating states exceeded the statutory minimum.
