Governor Northam Issues State of Emergency in Response to Hurricane Michael

In response to anticipated impacts from Hurricane Michael, Governor Northam has declared a State of Emergency. Contained within it are exemptions to

hours of service and weight waivers. See sections F and G. These waivers are intended for carriers transporting emergency relief supplies to and from

any area of the Commonwealth. Among the listed emergency supplies are heating oil, motor fuels and propane. The waivers are valid until November

11, unless rescinded sooner.

The activation of a State of Emergency also means that the state's price gouging law is now in effect.
