New Underground Storage Tank Requirements

The Virginia Department of Environmental Quality's guidance regarding the <u>New Underground Storage Tank (UST) Requirements</u> that owners and operators must meet by Jan. 1, 2021, is now final!

The document provides guidance on how DEQ will implement regulatory requirements related to:

- · Release detection for emergency generator USTs
- Spill prevention device, overfill prevention device and containment sump testing
- · Walk-through inspections
- Airport hydrant fueling system requirements
- · Field constructed tank requirements
