Congressmen Goodlatte, Griffith And Garrett Ask For Alternatives To Line 25 Closure

On Friday Congressmen Bob Goodlatte, Morgan Griffith, and Tom Garrett wrote to the Chairman of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, Neil Chatterjee, requesting that the agency work on regulatory options and infrastructure upgrades that might be an alternative to the planned closure of Line 25. This is a positive development, but this is but one chapter in an uphill effort.
